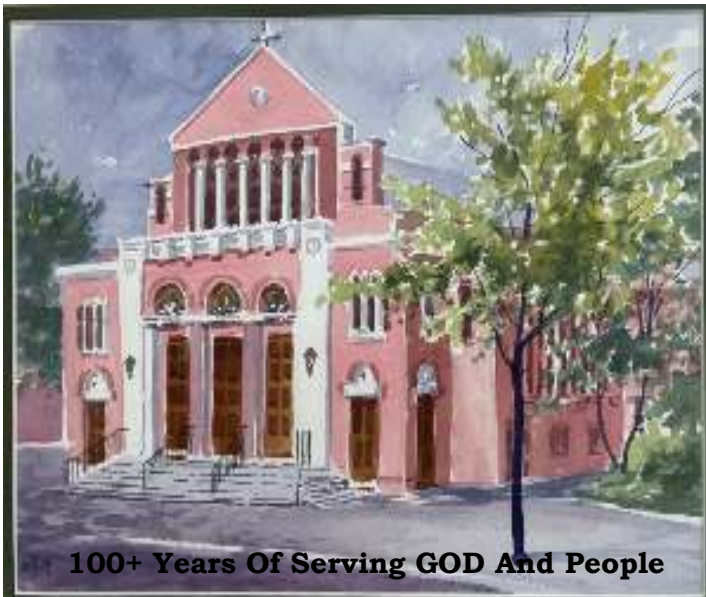

### Stewardship Reflection on the Lectionary Reading March 16, 2025—Second Sunday of Lent

In last week's Gospel, we followed Jesus into the desert where He fasted and prayed. This week, He leads us up a mountain to witness His Transfiguration. Why both of these experiences?

He is preparing us to go with Him in a few short weeks to a hilltop — Golgotha — where He will lay down His life for our sake, and then finally to take us to an empty cave where He triumphed over sin and death once and for all.

Jesus perfectly understands our humanity. He knows we need desert experiences — times of self-denial and testing — in order to arrive at mountain-top moments when we see and feel His glorious presence in our lives. The purpose of these two types of experiences is summed up in the description of the Apostles who were with Jesus at that mountain-top experience in today's Gospel: "Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory...."

The reason for all of our fasting and prayer and almsgiving during lent is to be reawakened to all God has done for humanity, and to all that He has done for each of us personally. It is all too easy to get lulled into complacency in our daily routines, to "sleepwalk" through life, getting up and getting ourselves out the door, going to work, returning home for dinner and dishes, meetings, or sports activities, and finally flopping on the couch to watch TV until bedtime. While there is nothing inherently sinful in this routine, as Christian stewards, we are called to so much more!

This lent, let us train ourselves, or more precisely, allow Him to train us to say "Yes" to His will and to offer our lives back to Him in gratitude. In so doing, we, too, will become "transfigured." This is what it means to live fully awake; this is a stewardship way of life and it is glorious indeed.

## From the Pastor's Desk

Greetings, and peace be with you. I am so glad you could join us, the parish community of St. Joan of Arc, for Mass today, the second Sunday of **Lent**. Our gospel reading from St. Luke has us join Jesus and three of his closest friends, Peter John and James, as they climb a high mountain. There, in prayer, Jesus is transfigured – “his clothing became dazzling white...two men...Moses and Elijah... appeared in glory and spoke of his (Jesus) exodus... to...Jerusalem.” This theophany took place before Jesus was to suffer at the hands of Pilate and others. Jesus is revealed as divine, but he will not need the three tents that Peter wants to set up for him and his forerunners. The chosen Son has come into the world to save it by obeying the Father's will. The disciples and we are invited to “listen to him.”

Last Sunday, I accompanied nine people from our parish to Immaculate Conception parish, Jamaica Estates, where they – and all the other candidates from Queens parishes - were *elected* by Bishop Brennan to finish their preparations for full initiation into the Catholic Church by means of the Easter Sacraments. Today, I travel to Our Lady of Angels parish in Brooklyn, where another five members of our parish will continue their conversion to Christ and prepare to receive the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist at Easter. Once again, Bishop Brennan will preside over the liturgy, which will bring together all the Brooklyn parishes. Please join me in praying for the Elect, and these five other members of our parish.

The reports from Rome that I have seen say that **Pope Francis'** health is improving. He is no longer in critical condition but still needs our prayers. As Pilgrims of Hope, let us put our trust and hope in the Lord.

Almsgiving is a recommended Lenten practice, and one of the ways we can give alms is through the **Annual Catholic Appeal**. Many of us who gave last year received a mailed invitation from the Appeal office. As I did last Saturday/Sunday, I hope you will make a generous pledge/gift to the 2025 Appeal. Early returns have started to come in, so I refer you to the second report of our parish progress, elsewhere in this Bulletin. Please see our parish website and Facebook page for a link to the 2025 ACA video. You will also find the QR code included in this Bulletin to make an electronic pledge. May God bless you all this Lent.

## Desde el escritorio del pastor

*Saludos y que la paz sea con ustedes. Me alegra mucho que hayan podido acompañarnos, la comunidad parroquial de Santa Juana de Arco, en la misa de hoy, segundo domingo de Cuaresma. Nuestro Evangelio según San Lucas nos lleva a acompañar a Jesús y a tres de sus amigos más cercanos, Pedro, Juan y*

*Santiago, mientras suben a una alta montaña. Allí, en oración, Jesús se transfigura: «Sus vestiduras se volvieron de una blancura resplandeciente... dos hombres... Moisés y Elías... aparecieron en gloria y hablaron de su éxodo (de Jesús)... a... Jerusalén». Esta teofanía tuvo lugar antes de que Jesús sufriera a manos de Pilato y otros. Jesús se revela como divino, pero no necesitará las tres tiendas que Pedro quiere levantar para él y sus precursores. El Hijo elegido ha venido al mundo para salvarlo obedeciendo la voluntad del Padre. Los discípulos y nosotros estamos invitados a «escucharlo».*

*El domingo pasado, acompañé a nueve personas de nuestra parroquia a la parroquia de la Inmaculada Concepción, en Jamaica Estates, donde ellos, junto con todos los demás candidatos de las parroquias de Queens, fueron elegidos por el obispo Brennan para finalizar sus preparativos para la iniciación plena en la Iglesia Católica mediante los sacramentos de Pascua. Hoy viajo a la parroquia de Nuestra Señora de los Ángeles en Brooklyn, donde otros cinco feligreses continuarán su conversión a Cristo y se prepararán para recibir los sacramentos de la Confirmación y la Eucaristía en Pascua. Una vez más, el obispo Brennan presidirá la liturgia, que reunirá a todas las parroquias de Brooklyn. Les pido que se unan a mí en oración por los Elegidos y por estos otros cinco feligreses.*

*Los informes que he recibido de Roma indican que la salud del **Papa Francisco** está mejorando. Ya no se encuentra en estado crítico, pero aún necesita nuestras oraciones. Como Peregrinos de la Esperanza, pongamos nuestra confianza y esperanza en el Señor.*

*La limosna es una práctica recomendada durante la Cuaresma, y una de las maneras en que podemos darla es a través de la **Campaña Católica Anual**. Muchos de los que donamos el año pasado recibimos una invitación por correo de la oficina de la Campaña. Al igual que yo el sábado y domingo pasados, espero que hagan una generosa promesa o donación a la Campaña 2025. Ya han comenzado a llegar las primeras contribuciones, así que les recomiendo el segundo informe sobre el progreso de nuestra parroquia, en otra parte de este Boletín.
