From the Pastor's Desk

Welcome to our parish community of St. Joan of Arc, on this **Fifth Sunday of Lent**. Today's gospel passage from St. John (8:1-11) tells the story of a woman (unnamed) who is brought before Jesus by the scribes and Pharisees in the temple area. They accuse her of adultery, and want Jesus to pronounce judgement on her, the penalty prescribed by the Mosaic law – death by stoning. Instead, Jesus addresses the accusers: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." When Jesus finally does speak to this woman, he asks: "Woman, where are they (her accusers)? Has no one condemned you?...Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin any more." In these closing days of Lent (next Sunday is Palm Sunday!), let us seek out the Lord in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, who also does not condemn us, but wants to forgive us, and reconcile us to the Father and to the Church.

Last week, as you may have read or heard, I took part in a diocesan priest retreat at the former seminary in Huntington, Long Island. The theme was "The priest as disciple." While there, I had some time to read most of **Pope Francis' autobiography, "Hope."** I enjoyed it, and recommend it, but I admit it is a challenging book. He finished it just before he came down with double pneumonia and had to be hospitalized for over a month. He is home now, but his doctors have insisted that he convalesce for the next two months. And I suggest **we continue our prayers for him** during that time. According to published reports in the press, his doctors feared that they would "lose" him – twice. What helped him through that ordeal? I believe it was the prayers of so many, here and around the world.

I'd like to call to mind last weeks' notice about a new Missalette and Hymnal - **Unidos en Cristo / United in Christ**, and the invitation to make a free-will offering to offset the cost. We will get some years of use from this new worship aid, so that is encouraging. And the print is bigger, which will help us all see and sing better. Just put your donation in an envelope marked with your name/address and "Hymnal Offering" clearly visible and drop it in the collection basket at Mass, or bring it to the parish office (rectory). Thank you.

Almsgiving is a recommended Lenten practice. we can address this in part by making a pledge or gift to the **2025 Annual Catholic Appeal**. If you did not receive a personal invitation in your mail from the Bishop or the Appeal office, please notice that pledge envelopes around the church. I hope you will make a generous pledge/gift to this year's Appeal. A new report – March 31 - has come in, so I refer you to it elsewhere in this Bulletin. Please see our parish website and Facebook page for a link to the 2025 ACA video. You will also find the QR code included in this Bulletin to make an electronic pledge.

Desde el escritorio del pastor

*Bienvenidos a nuestra comunidad parroquial de Santa Juana de Arco, en este **quinto domingo de Cuaresma**. El pasaje del Evangelio de hoy, según San Juan (8,1-11), narra la historia de una mujer (sin nombre) que es llevada ante Jesús por los escribas y fariseos en el templo. La acusación de adulterio y exigen que Jesús la juzgue, la pena prescrita por la ley mosaica: la muerte por lapidación. En cambio, Jesús se dirige a los acusadores: «El que esté sin pecado, que le tire la primera piedra». Cuando Jesús finalmente se dirige a esta mujer, le pregunta: «Mujer, ¿dónde están (sus acusadores)? ¿Nadie te ha condenado?... Yo tampoco te condeno. Vete, y de ahora en adelante no peques más». En estos últimos días de Cuaresma (¡el próximo domingo es Domingo de Ramos!), busquemos al Señor en el Sacramento de la Reconciliación, quien tampoco nos condena, sino que quiere perdonarnos y reconciliarnos con el Padre y con la Iglesia.*

*La semana pasada, como habrán leído o escuchado, participé en un retiro diocesano para sacerdotes en el antiguo seminario de Huntington, Long Island. El tema fue "El sacerdote como discípulo". Durante mi estancia allí, tuve tiempo para leer la mayor parte de la **autobiografía del Papa Francisco, "Esperanza"**. La disfruté y la recomiendo, pero admito que es un libro difícil. Lo terminó justo antes de contraer una neumonía doble y tener que estar hospitalizado durante más de un mes. Ya está en casa, pero sus médicos han insistido en que convalezca durante los próximos dos meses. Y les sugiero que sigamos **orando por él durante ese tiempo**. Según informes publicados en la prensa, sus médicos temieron perderlo dos veces. ¿Qué lo ayudó a superar esa dura prueba? Creo que fueron las oraciones de muchos, aquí y en todo el mundo.*

*Quiero recordar el anuncio de la semana pasada sobre un nuevo **Misal e Himnario: Unidos en Cristo**, y la invitación a hacer una ofrenda voluntaria para compensar el costo. Usaremos esta nueva guía para el culto durante algunos años, lo cual es alentador. Además, la letra es más grande, lo que nos ayudará a ver y cantar mejor. Simplemente coloque su donación en un sobre con su nombre, dirección y la palabra "Ofrenda del Himnario" claramente visible, y deposítela en la canasta de la misa o llévela a la oficina parroquial (rectoría).*

MUSIC MINISTRY

Music is a very important element in our public prayer, and especially our celebration of the sacred mysteries, such as the Mass. Here at St. Joan of Arc, we pray in two (sometimes three) languages: English and Spanish (sometimes Tagalog). To help us pray, we have purchased new missalettes and new hymnals (bilingual) Unidos en Cristo / United in Christ. They are published by Oregon Catholic Press (OCP) and are used in quite a few parishes here in our diocese and around the country. We will start to use them in Holy Week, and they will replace our current worship aids. Because they are meant to be used together, we have agreed to purchase vinyl covers that permit both books to be in one "package." That package must remain in the churches (up and down) for our communal use. Quality comes at a price, and so we are asking you, our faithful parishioners and friends, to make a free-will offering to help offset the cost of this upgrade to our public prayer aids. Donations (in an envelope with your name/address so we can thank you) can be dropped off at the Rectory or given to a priest, deacon, parish usher or sacristan. Thank you and God bless you. - **Msgr.
