“Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?”



This beautiful line from the Gospel captures one of the most powerful moments in all of Scripture. The disciples, walking along the road with Jesus, do not immediately recognize Him. Yet something within them stirs. Their hearts burn as He speaks, as He opens the Scriptures, as He engages them in a conversation that is anything but ordinary.

It makes me reflect on the nature of our own conversations. So much of our daily speech is spent on what is superficial. We speak about the weather, about sports, about the latest comment someone made on a social media platform. Even when we engage important topics, such as politics, social concerns, current events, discussions can easily become nothing more than noise if they are not rooted in truth and directed toward something higher.

In a world filled with constant chatter, social media scrolling, and conversations that rarely go beneath the surface, how often do we experience what the disciples did? How often do our hearts truly burn within us?

Jesus gives us the example. He walks with His disciples. He listens. He speaks. He opens their minds and their hearts to something deeper. This is not small talk. This is transformative encounter. These are the kinds of conversations that strengthen friendships, build community, and lead us closer to God.

We are given that same opportunity, especially at Mass. At Mass the Scriptures are opened to us. We are invited to listen, to reflect, and to enter into something far greater than the ordinary exchanges of daily life. And in the breaking of the bread, Christ is made known to us once again.

The Mass becomes a refuge from the noise. It is a place where we step away from shallow conversation and enter into divine dialogue. It is where our hearts can once again be set on fire.

What a gift this is. And what a blessing that, even today, the Lord still walks with us, still speaks to us, and still sets our hearts ablaze.

*Amigos:*

*«¿Acaso no ardía nuestro corazón mientras nos hablaba en el camino y nos explicaba las Escrituras?»*

*Esta hermosa frase del Evangelio capta uno de los momentos más poderosos de toda la Escritura. Los discípulos, caminando por el camino junto a Jesús, no lo reconocen de inmediato. Sin embargo, algo se renueva en su interior. Sus corazones arden mientras Él habla, mientras les explica las Escrituras, mientras entabla con ellos una conversación que dista mucho de ser ordinaria.*

*Esto me invita a reflexionar sobre la naturaleza de nuestras propias conversaciones. Gran parte de nuestro diálogo diario se consume en lo superficial. Hablamos del tiempo, de deportes, del último comentario que alguien hizo en una red social. Incluso cuando abordamos temas importantes — como la política, las inquietudes sociales o la actualidad—, las discusiones pueden convertirse fácilmente en nada más que ruido si no están arraigadas en la verdad y orientadas hacia algo superior.*

*En un mundo repleto de parloteo constante, de deslizar el dedo por las redes sociales y de conversaciones que rara vez profundizan más allá de la superficie, ¿con qué frecuencia experimentamos lo que vivieron los discípulos? ¿Con qué frecuencia arden verdaderamente nuestros corazones en nuestro interior?*

*Jesús nos da el ejemplo. Él camina con sus discípulos. Él escucha. Él habla. Él abre sus mentes y sus corazones a algo más profundo. Esto no es una charla trivial. Es un encuentro transformador. Son el tipo de conversaciones que fortalecen las amistades, construyen comunidad y nos acercan más a Dios.*

*A nosotros se nos ofrece esa misma oportunidad, especialmente en la Misa. En la Misa se nos abren las Escrituras. Se nos invita a escuchar, a reflexionar y a adentrarnos en algo mucho más grande que los intercambios ordinarios de la vida cotidiana. Y, en la fracción del pan, Cristo se nos da a conocer una vez más.*

*La Misa se convierte en un refugio frente al ruido. Es un lugar donde nos apartamos de las conversaciones superficiales para entrar en un diálogo divino. Es el lugar donde nuestros corazones pueden volver a encenderse.*

*¡Qué gran regalo es este! Y qué bendición que, incluso hoy, el Señor siga caminando con nosotros, siga hablándonos y siga haciendo arder nuestros corazones.*
